General Rules

1. All exhibitors must have adequate public liability insurance
2. It is the exhibitors responsibility to check if the show is still taking place due to bad weather.
3. The organiser reserves the right to refuse any entry.
4. The organiser reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes.
5. No responsibilities will be accepted by the organiser for accidents or damage to riders, competitors, spectators, owners or animals or any other property.
6. The decision of the judge is final.
7. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not. Any objections or protest must be made in writing to the secretary accompanied by a fee of £50 which may be forfeited to the show funds in the event of the objection being overruled.
8. No litter is to be left on the showground. CLEAN AND OUT OF HORSEBOXES AND TRAILERS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.
9. Under no circumstances is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal.
10. All grooms entering the ring must be correctly dressed and must wear a hat in the ring.
11. Heritage Section. 1st prize money will only be given if there are 6 entries or less.
12. Lead rein competitors must be aged 3 and over.
13. In the Lead rein sections the lead rein must be fixed to the noseband.
14. In lead rein snaffle bits only.
15. No tying up on trailers and wagons.
16. Whips not to exceed 75cms (30inc)
17. Competitors to carry passports at all times.

Rules for Equifest qualifications:

SPILLER/EQUIFEST MOUNTAINS AND MORLAND IN HAND

Open to In hand Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A,B,C,D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding any age.

This class may be divided as appropriate.

THE HEWITT FAMILY/EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND.

Open to In hand Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A,B,C,D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding 4 years old and over. Rider any age

This class may be divided as appropriate.

CAVERNOMA ALLIANCE UK/ EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN.

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and show in a snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

NATHAN ARNOLD SHOW TEAM/EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN.

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

KBIS/EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

Show Hunter Ponies, mare or gelding 4 years and over not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Classes may be divided as follows:

- Mare or gelding, 4 years and over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years and over, exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms. Rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Rider not the have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms. Rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

NUPAFEEDE/EQUIFEST RIDING HORSE

Open Riding horse mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Rider any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

- Small Riding Horse – mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Rider any age.
- Large Riding Horse – mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 158cms. Riders any age,

NUPAFEEED/ EQUIFEST RIDDEN COB

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

- Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms
- Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding. Exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES /EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 153cms. Rider any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

- Light weight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone.
- Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone.
- Heavy weight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying over 14 stone.

TGCA Rules for classes

TGCA TOYS IN HAND AND RIDDEN CLASSES Show Number TGCA 06/17/064

These classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Associations (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Top Three in each class qualify. In open height classes, top three in small and larger sections qualify.

Stallions – All stallions (Four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MSUT have their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non members will receive a qualifications card from the judge and will have 21 days to join the TGCA and to register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

QUEST CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

1ST, 2ND AND 3RD from the TGCA classes may go forward to the Quest for a start Championship. **Provided** they are current YGCA members and the horse is TGCA registered. Membership cards and qualification cards (specific to that Exhibit) must be presented upon entry to the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

TSR Showing Finals

TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2017 TSR Regional Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers **MUST** have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards - TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

BSHA Grass Roots & SHGB Riding Club Champs - With a TSR qualification card you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Champs in Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. BSPS Rules

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society ("B.S.P.S"), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S classes whether or not a member of the B.S.P.S are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S, including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consent to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

B.S.P.S "Classic Security UK Ltd" CHALLENGE

All summer qualifying shows that are affiliated to the B.S.P.S are qualifiers for the "The B.S.P.S Challenge" and schedules must state:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Show Pony, SHP, WHO, Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, Int SRT, SH,WH, and Heritage M&M Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP. This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge, Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any B.S.P.S affiliated show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2017 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class.

B.S.P.S PREMIER LEAGUE.

This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S Premier League, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th placed ponies in the Lead rein, First Ridden, 128cms, 138cms, and 148 cms Show Pony. Lead Rein Hunter Type, 122cms, 133cms, 143cms, 153cms Show Hunter Ponies, Cradle and Nursery Stakes 133cms, 143cms, 153cms Working Hunter Pony, Intermediate Show Riding, Show Hunter and Working Hunter classes and the Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden Small A & B & C & D's and the Large Breeds and the Open Heritage WHP classes and 1st to 4th in the Mixed Height Open Classes.

HERITAGE "Industrial Salt Supplies" WOW FACTOR

Open to ponies that have been places First in Heritage affiliated Open/ Restricted classes during the Winter and Summer Season to qualify for the "Winner of Winners" at the B.S.P.S Summer Championship.

B.S.P.S "Black Country Saddles" BEST RIDER

This show is a qualifier for the "B.S.P.S Best Rider of the Year". The Best Rider in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Lead Rein Hunter Type, 128cms, 138cms and 148cms Show Pony, the 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms SHP, the Cradle and Nursery Stakes, the 133cms, 143cms and 153cms WHP, the Intermediate Show Riding Type, Show Hunter, Working Hunter classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden and the best 25 year old and under in the Heritage Ridden and WHP classes will receive a card and qualify for the final at the B.S.P.S Summer Championship Show.
