# Sheep Section

## Rules and Terms of Entry

1. All exhibitors must have public liability insurance
2. All sheep and lambs must be tagged with UK flock number and individually as per DEFRA guidelines.
3. All sheep movements must be accompanied by a fully completed movement form – a separate form is required for movements both on and off the showground, please present the forms to the livestock secretary's tent on arrival.
4. Sheep are the responsibility of their owner and Todmorden Country Fair can not be held responsible for loss, damage or injury to sheep, property or vehicles.
5. Should veterinary advice or services be required, this will be at the owners expense.
6. It is recommended that all sheep brought to the show ground be protected from sheep scab.
7. The society reserve the right to refuse entry of any sheep showing indications of any contagious disease.
8. No entries will be accepted unless it is on an official entry form which can be requested from [sheep@todmordencountryfair.co.uk](mailto:sheep@todmordencountryfair.co.uk) or downloaded from [www.todmordencountryfair.co.uk](http://www.todmordencountryfair.co.uk) and accompanied by the correct fee, sent to the livestock secretary.
9. Cheques must be made payable to Todmorden Country Fair
10. Sheep must be penned by 9.30am and must not leave the showground before 4pm.
11. There must be competition in all classes therefore Todmorden Country Fair reserves the right to create or amalgamate classes and restrict the prize money in the event of insufficient entries.
12. The judge's decision will be final and binding.

## Entry Fees and Prizes

1. Entry Fee: £1 per entry
2. Entries close Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2017
3. Prize money will be awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> - £8 2<sup>nd</sup> - £5 3<sup>rd</sup> - £3
4. Young Handlers prize money is as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> - £5 2<sup>nd</sup> - £4 3<sup>rd</sup> - £3 4<sup>th</sup> - £2
5. The winner of each class will qualify through to the breed championship where champion male, female and overall breed champion will be selected. Breed champion will enter the Interbreed Championship (to follow on from judging)
6. Winners of the group of three and young handler are not eligible to compete in breed championships.

# Cattle Section

## Rules and Terms of Entry

1. All exhibitors must have public liability insurance
2. All cattle must be double tagged as per DEFRA guidelines and will be checked against entry forms on arrival.
3. All cattle passports must be taken to the cattle secretary up on arrival.
4. All cattle movements must be reported to BCMS, stickers available from cattle secretary's tent.
5. Cattle are the responsibility of their owner and Todmorden Country Fair can not be held responsible for loss, damage or injury to cattle, people, property or vehicles.
6. Should veterinary advice or services be required, this will be at the owners expense.
7. The society reserve the right to refuse entry of any cattle showing indications of any contagious disease (e.g. Ringworm).
8. Bovine Tuberculosis: Cattle from all bTB parishes will be accepted only if all correct paperwork is provided.
9. All beef cattle/dual purpose cattle must be shown with a metal clip in their nose.
10. Animals that calve or show evidence of calving whilst on the showground must be placed in the approved isolation accommodation and must be removed as early as possible from the showground.
11. If an animal calves prematurely or aborts whilst on the showground, the divisional veterinary officer must be informed immediately the animal must be removed from the showground together with all animals from the same registered premises after required samples taken.
12. No entries will be accepted unless it is on an official entry form which can be requested from [cattle@todmordencountryfair.co.uk](mailto:cattle@todmordencountryfair.co.uk) or downloaded from [www.todmordencountryfair.co.uk](http://www.todmordencountryfair.co.uk) and accompanied by the correct fee, sent to the cattle secretary.
13. Cheques must be made payable to Todmorden Country Fair
14. Cattle must be unloaded by 9.00am and must not leave the showground before 4pm.
15. There must be competition in all classes therefore Todmorden Country Fair reserves the right to create or amalgamate classes and restrict the prize money in the event of insufficient entries.
16. The judge's decision will be final and binding.

## **Entry Fees and Prizes**

1. Entry Fee: £5 per entry
2. Entries close Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2017
3. Prize money will be awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> - £25 2<sup>nd</sup> - £15 3<sup>rd</sup> - £10
4. The winner of each class will qualify through to the section championship where champion male, female (where applicable) and overall section champion will be selected.
5. Winners of the pairs classes are not eligible to compete in breed championships.

## **Classes**

### **Dairy Cattle Classes – Any dairy breed**

**Class 1 – Maiden heifer, less than 12 months of age on day of show**

**Class 2 – Maiden heifer , over 12 months of age on day of show**

**Class 3 – Heifer in milk (calved below three years of age)**

**Class 4 – Cow in milk, 2 or more lactations**

**Class 5 – Best pair from one exhibitor, shown in classes 1-4 (rosettes only, no entry fee)**

### **Native Bred Cattle**

**Class 6 – Cow in calf or calf at foot**

**Class 7 – Native heifer**

**Class 8 – Native Bull (any age)**

**Class 9 – Best pair from one exhibitor, shown in classes 6-8 (rosettes only, no entry fee)**

### **Continental Bred Cattle**

**Class 10 – Continental cow in calf or calf at foot**

**Class 11 – Continental Heifer**

**Class 12 – Continental Bull (any age)**

**Class 13 – Best pair from one exhibitor, shown in classes 10-12 (rosettes only, no entry fee)**

### **Commercial Beef Cattle**

**Class 14 – Commercial Beef Steer**

**Class 15 – Commercial Beef Heifer**

**Class 16 – Best pair from one exhibitor, shown in classes 14-16 (rosettes only, no entry fee)**
